What is Sáde Resources:

- Sáde Resources is a community platform for practitioners, policy makers and civil society members that come to discuss all aspects of stabilization, recovery and development effort around the Lake Chad region which covers four countries – Cameroon, Niger, Nigeria, and Chad.
- The platform is also a space for the Sáde community to network and interact while acting as a dynamic tool for improved coordination and crisis response in the Lake Chad Basin. Sáde Resources also serves as a repository for policy documents, strategies and action plans, assessment reports, lessons learnt and good practices for the region and the global space.

What are Sade Resources Communities of Practice:

Sade Resources Communities of Practice is a group of people who share a concern or passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly. While acknowledging that there are significant differences between COPs across organizations and needs, all COPs include three common characteristics:

- A domain, which is the thematic area or key issues of focus;
- A community, or COP-members, that creates the social fabric necessary for learning;
- A practice space, that consists of shared tools, frameworks, language, stories etc.

Guiding Principles for the COPs:

- Ensure knowledge is available and preserved, promoting shared learning;
- Deepen engagement and allow community members to discuss areas of mutual interest;
- Foster non-siloed ways of working and facilitate increased collaboration;
- Provide a safe space for brainstorming and experimentation

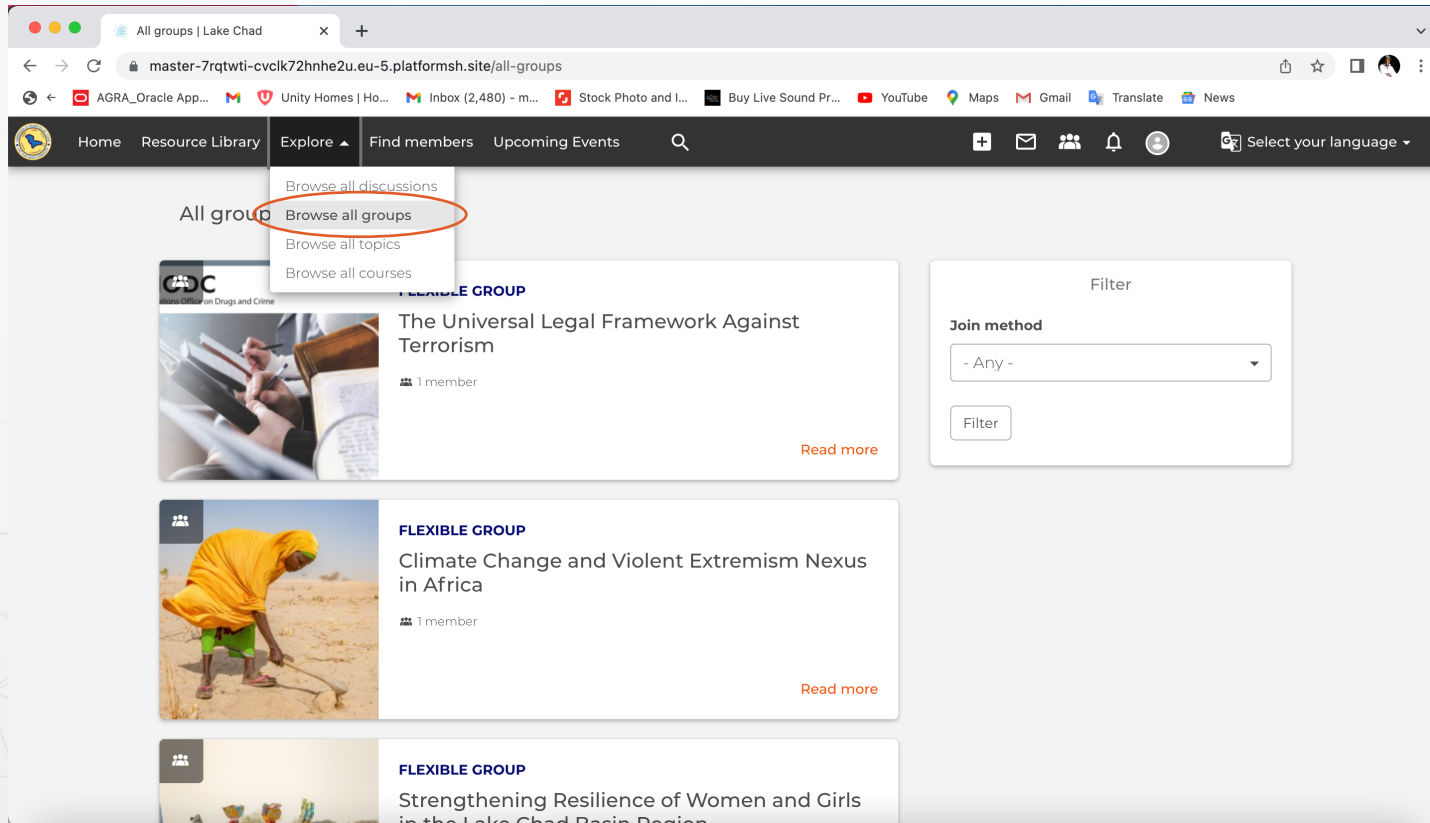

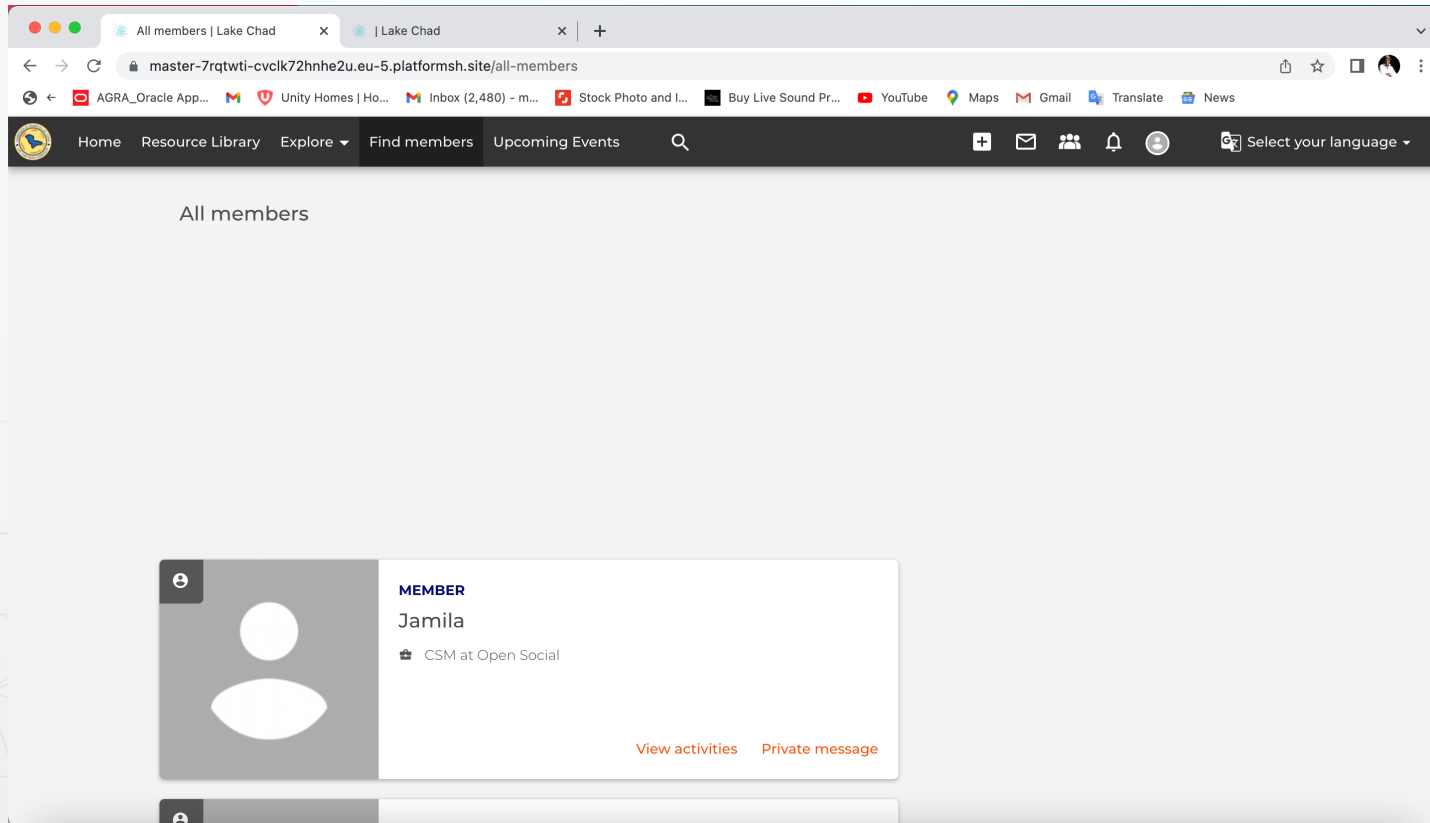
